District 9 Regatta Report

Sun Apr 24th, 2011 through Fri Apr 29th, 2011

43rd Semaine Olympique Française



Final results for the ISAF World Cup, Hyeres, France.

Day One: Perfect conditions blessed the first day of competition in the Semaine Olympique Francaise, fourth event in the ISAF Sailing World Cup. The easterly breeze in the Mediterranean Sea ranging from 12 to 18 knots in the seven different racing areas, big waves and sun provided for excellent racing in Hyeres and saw many favourites taking the honors.

Americans posted strong scores in the Star, with George Szabo/ Mark Strube and Andrew Campbell/ Ian Coleman in second and third respectively behind Brazil's Robert Scheidt and Bruno Prada.

Day Two: With decreasing winds forecast for later in the week, it was a day of hurry up and wait on day two of the Semaine Olympique Francaise as start times were moved up to stay on schedule, but morning winds proved insufficient for racing. Following postponements, light to medium winds arrived.

The Star class had one of the longest day on the water with three long races. Three places in the top four have given early leaders Robert Scheidt and Bruno Prada (BRA) a ten point lead over George Szabo and Mark Strube (USA). "We arrived at the yacht club early for a 9am start time, but were postponed on shore," noted Szabo. "It was a tough day on the water starting off with a big 30-plus degree wind shift on the first beat of first race. The race committee did a good job getting us three races, although we had lots of recalls. We finally got back on land around 6pm."

Day Three: The objective of the day was to finish the program before the final stage has been reached! Sailing started late due to summery weather, more appropriate for lazing in the shade than sailing a regatta! The chances to conclude the qualifications looked grim but finally by 8PM the last boats came back to the dock after a long day of wait and sail.

Two French teams are in the Star class top three. Guillaume Florent and Pascal Rambeau won the unique race of the day to place second in front of Xavier Rohart and Pierre-Alexis Ponsot, who were second in the race. Robert Scheidt and Bruno Prada keep their earlier overall lead.

Day Four: Despite scoring their worse score so far in the regatta, Robert Scheidt and Bruno Prada (BRA) are conserving the lead in the Star fleet. "We have lead the regatta since day one. We started well and can finish well.

"We are really happy with our results because we had difficult conditions and we raced consistently. There are still four races to go, tomorrow will be a big day so we will see how we go." Today's only race's win went to Croatian Marin Lovrovic and Sinisa Mikulicic (CRO).

Day Five: Last racing before the medal race in the fourth ISAF Sailing World Cup in Hyères concluded with seven early winners in the Olympic and Paralympic classes. Robert Scheidt (BRA) is leaving his print in the Star class, leading the event from day one with crew Bruno Prada. They have already won the event. Second place before the medal race is Xavier Rohart and Pierre-Alexis Ponsot and third to Diego Negri and Enrico Voltolini (ITA).

Medal Race: Robert Scheidt and Bruno Prada (BRA) who had won the event already yesterday, took also the Medal Race. "We had a consistent week, and it is great because the weather conditions were hard and the fleet really strong. We will race a lot this year to try and keep our best level, hopefully until the Olympics."

French team of Xavier Rohart and Pierre-Alexis Ponsot conserved the second place on the podium while 2009 World Champions George Szabo and Mark Strube (USA) took Bronze after a second in the Medal race. "This result is very encouraging. We have worked hard these last months. We have better communication and decisions on the water," explained the French pair.
